FLORAL AND CRAFT

Children are to bring their containers, flowers and other items to school on Thursday morning 18th October. An opportunity will be provided for all children to do their arrangements during the day. Indoor show entries must be prepared at school.

COOKING (Judged)

This section is optional. The baking must be done at home and be delivered to the Events Centre between 8.15am and 9am Thursday 18th October. Late arrivals will not be judged, but will be accepted for display only.

Cakes to be displayed top side up. The cooking will be judged. All cooking to have names out of view for the judging.

5 & 6 year olds

- A. 3 decorated gingerbread people—cutters may be used.
- B. 3 vanilla wine biscuits (bought) with decorated faces

7 & 8 year olds

- C. 3 Decorated gingerbread people—cutters may be used.
- D. 3 Vanilla wine biscuits (bought) with decorated faces
- E. 1 Decorated Cup Cake

9 & 10 year olds

- F. Uniced chocolate cake (conventional oven)
- G. 1 Gingerbread Person/animal (no stencils to be used)
- H. 3 pieces of Uncooked Slice
- I. Decorated Cake
- J. 3 Decorated Cup Cakes

11 years and over

- K. 3 Yo-yos/Melting Moments (2 biscuits joined together with a filling)
- L. 3 pieces cooked slice
- M. Decorated Cake
- N. 3 Meringues

JUNIOR

Rooms 1, 2, 3, (Bring Flowers for items 1 & 2)

All made at school.

1. Vaseline saucer
2. Posy in Decorated Tin (Tin decorated prior to Ag Day)
3. Decorated Pet Rock (made at school)

Room 4 & 5 (Bring Flowers for items 1, & 2)

These will be made at school prior to Ag Day.

1. Vaseline Saucer
2. Posy in Decorated Tin (Tin decorated prior to Ag Day)
3. Paper Flower Bouquet

The children will receive house points for participation for all of the above.

JUNIOR INDOOR INSTRUCTIONS TO BE MADE AT SCHOOL ON THURSDAY

Vaseline Saucer – (Rooms 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5)

Made at school. Saucer will be smeared thinly inside with vaseline and decorated with flower petals and leaves. Bring flowers to school on Thursday. Saucer will be provided.

Pet Rock - (Rooms 1,2, 3)

Made at school.

Posy in decorated tin (420g size) – (Rooms 1,2,3,4 & 5)

Made at school. Bring flowers from home with stems.

Paper Flower Bouquet – (Rooms 4 & 5)

Made at school.

MIDDLE

Rooms 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 (Bring Materials for at least 3 items)

1. Miniature scene to represent New Zealand
2. Tennis Ball person or creature
3. Art Display (made at school)
4. Recycled Creature
5. Sand Saucer
6. Photo Frame

The children will receive house points for participation for all of the above.

MIDDLE INDOOR INSTRUCTIONS **TO BE MADE AT SCHOOL ON THURSDAY**

Miniature Scene -Create a scene that represents New Zealand. It can be scenery, an activity or an environment.

Have a plan. Make in a small tray/box or baking dish.

Tennis Ball Person/Creation - Bring own tennis ball and stand: yoghurt pots or plastic cups are great, stand is not judged. Can use cardboard, feathers, material etc. Glue gun available.

Recycled Creature – Freestanding creature made from clean recycled material that can go in the recycle bin (no glass). Hot glue gun available.

Sand Saucer- Bring your own saucer or side plate and sand. Make a design using flowers and or greenery. All sand must be covered.

Decorated Photo Frame – Cardboard template provided. Decorate with any objects you choose. Be creative and imaginative. Photo optional. (6x4 size)

SENIOR

Rooms 11,12,13, 14 & 15 (Bring Materials for at least 3 items)

1. Flax flowers
2. Novelty Animals from natural material
3. Rubbings to show mathematical concepts
4. Flower arrangement in a novelty container
5. Aqua Jar

The children will receive house points for participation for all of the above.

SENIOR INDOOR INSTRUCTIONS TO BE MADE AT SCHOOL ON THURSDAY

Flax Flower - Made at school.

Novelty Animals— made from natural materials, no foods.

e.g. pine cones, twigs, driftwood, acorns. Must be free standing.

Rubbings— Rubbings of leaves, bark or plant material.

Concepts: reflection, rotation, tessellation, etc.

Flower arrangement in a novelty container - Choose flowers and arrange in an unusual container, old shoe, nice bottle, tin can etc. Do not hide the shape of the container with your arrangement. The flowers must be in water in the novelty container.

Aqua Jar - A flower or arrangement attached to a jar lid with a neat mound of plasticine and lowered into the jar filled with water. When inverted it makes an attractive display. Try to avoid any water bubbles by filling the jar to the brim before lowering in the flower. Any type of clear jar will do as long as it has a screw top.

Try a little glitter for effect. Flowers should not touch jar sides/top.
